Class Dojo

Class Dojo was introduced back at the beginning of the pandemic to support online learning from home. The use of this platform has been successful, and we will be continuing with its use.

We have updated our Class Dojo Policy, which can be found on our website.



For convenience, here are some of the key parts of the parent/carer section of this policy:

- Only parents/carers or legal guardians will be given access codes to Class Dojo.
- Parents/carers can view their child's portfolio, class story and school story feeds. They may interact with posts and submit to their child's portfolio.
- Parents/carers may message their child's class teacher; however, a response will only be given during the hours of 7:30am – 5:30pm on school days. Outside of these hours, teacher profiles are set to 'quiet time'.
- Parents/carers should be aware that teachers will not necessarily respond to messages straight away but will endeavour to do so when practicably possible. They may also not read the message that you have sent until the end of the day.
- The following matters should always go through the school office:
 - Absence (such as medical appointments)
 - Sickness
 - School dinner queries
 - Complaints
 - Urgent messages (e.g. collection of children)
- It is the parent/carer responsibility to ensure information is provided through the appropriate channels.
- Parents/carers must be respectful when messaging teachers or commenting on the class news feed. Any inappropriate comments will be deleted, and the service may be removed.
- Parents/carers must ensure that their child uses Class Dojo safely.



Attendance

At Hemsby Primary School, we expect children to attend every day. Research shows that regular attendance is directly linked to raising achievement and helps build skills for life, developing children's confidence and helping them to make and keep lasting friendships.

What should I do if my child is absent from school?

- Contact the School Office to leave a message giving the reason for absence.
- If your child has sickness or diarrhoea, please keep them off school for 48 hours to reduce the spread of infection.
