Just a few polite reminders:

- It is important that pupils have a good night's sleep and arrive at school on time each day.
- We will be holding a no charge 'SATs breakfast' every morning at 8:30am before the tests, 9th – 12th May. This is optional but will give your child a chance to be in school



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early, to have something to eat with their friends and to settle in before the tests. Pupils will have a selection of bagels and toppings, cereal bars and fresh fruit. We will provide milk, squash or water to drink.
